In the Government Order read at (1) above, a Technical Committee was constituted under the Chairmanship of Dr. Mukund Kadursrinivas Rao to guide, to define procedures, suggest detailed plan of activities under K-GIS to facilitate framing of entire project and in the Government Order cited under ref (2) above the Technical Committee has been expanded with three additional members.

2) In the 31st Executive Committee meeting of KRSAC held on 02-07-2016, while reviewing implementation of K-GIS, the Chairperson has suggested to re-constitute the K-GIS Technical Committee by inclusion of Mr. Brijesh Kumar, IFS, CCF, Karnataka Forest Department and Mr. Shantanu Bhatawdekar, Scientist / Engineer-G/ Associate Director, EOS, ISRO Headquarters, Bengaluru, as representative from ISRO and Dr. P. K. Srivastava, Chief Technical Officer of K-GIS project as Member Secretary, K-GIS Technical Committee and Director, KRSAC as Member convener in the K-GIS Technical Committee.

3) The proposal of Director KRSAC has been examined hence the following orders.

2) The Technical Committee shall meet once in every 3 months. The agenda for the meeting shall be prepared by K-GIS Mission.

3) The K-GIS Technical Committee shall guide KRSAC to define procedures and detailed plan of activities under K-GIS to facilitate framing of the project by KRSAC. Detailed K-GIS frame work document should be made available by end of March, 2017.

4) The KRSAC shall consult stakeholder Departments to ascertain their GIS requirements etc within the K-GIS framework and document them. The Technical committee shall examine this user-need document and make its recommendations to KRSAC to improve the services.

- 5) The Executive Committee of Karnataka State Remote Sensing Applications Center is vested with all the powers including financial approvals and will guide the K-GIS project.
- 6) The expenditure on this shall be met out of K-GIS project funds.
- 7) The tenure of the reconstituted K-GIS Technical Committee shall be for a period of one year from the date of issue of orders.
- 8) The proposal for payment of sitting fees to be placed by the Director, KRSAC before the Executive Committee separately.
